He is also known by his titles Chin Qilich Khan (awarded by Aurangzeb in 1690-91), Nizam-ul-Mulk (awarded by Farrukhsiyar in 1713) and Asaf Jah (awarded by Muhammad Shah in 1725). From 12 Jul 1737 he liked to called himself as Asaf Jah.Â Nadir Shah entered Delhi in 1738 and ordered it to be looted and ransacked along with a general genocide of its citizens.Â She was the first of his seven wives and 42 concubines, and the mother of two eldest of his sons Azam Jah and Moazzam Jah.
