Buying Options. From this point of view, plans and interiors are inappropriate to the book's aim, which is to serve as a guide to architectural styles, not as a history or criticism of them. If the book inspires the building watcher to cross the threshold into a deeper understanding of the buildings and their stylistic features, into an inside-out knowledge of architecture, then so much the better. Each style is illustrated with several photographs (there are almost 200 in all) arranged so that each group in forms visually to best advantage.

American Georgian architecture encompassed three distinct styles: (1) The Baroque idiom of Sir Christopher Wren (1632-1723) and his followers. (2) The Palladian style of Renaissance architecture invented by the designer Andrea Palladio (1508-80), which introduced the balanced and symmetrical features for which Georgian designs are famous. (3) The Neoclassical style - a reversion to Greek and Roman architectural principles - which came into fashion in the second half of the 18th century. See below for more details. Revivalist Greek architecture involved closer adherence to the values and stylistic models of Greek art (c.450-27 BCE). The firm produced a stream of classical buildings to rival anything seen since the heyday of Roman art and engineering.
