Western philosophy refers to the philosophical thought and work of the Western world. Historically, the term refers to the philosophical thinking of Western culture, beginning with Greek philosophy of the pre-Socratics such as Thales (c. 624 – c. 546 BC) and Pythagoras (c. 570 – c. 495 BC), and eventually covering a large area of the globe. The word philosophy itself originated from the Ancient Greek *φιλοσοφία* (*phílosophía*), literally, "the love of wisdom" (*φίλος* *phílos*, "to love" and *σοφία* *sophía* – A.L.
