Most insects are quite specific as to habitat A literature review is usually written as part of a postgraduate thesis proposal or at the beginning of a dissertation or thesis. A literature review gives an overview of the area of study: what has already been said on the topic; who the key writers are; what the prevailing theories and hypotheses are; what questions are being asked; and what methodologies are appropriate and useful. DO NOT confuse your essay format with an annotated bibliography which describes and evaluates individual texts. Example plan. Introduction Topic sentence that states the broad topic of your thesis Following sentence/s that state what is included/excluded (parameters) Final sentence/s that signals list of key topics that will be used to discuss the selected sources.

Annotated bibliographies and literature reviews are both comprehensive collections of relevant sources, but that is where the similarity ends. Their purposes, structures, and components are very different.

	Purpose	Structure
Annotated Bibliography	Provides the reader with an ordered list of sources for additional reading.	An annotated bibliography examines each source based on its relationship to the topic; a literature review draws together multiple sources to examine where they agree or disagree.
Literature Review	An annotated bibliography must organize sources alphabetically, but a literature review is likely to use problem/solution, cause/effect, comparison/contrast, classification/division, or process to organize sources.

A taphocoenosis including remains of insects and small mammals from the Quaternary deposits in the vicinity of the village of Kalistratikha (Altai Region, Russia) on the Ob River is revealed. The ^{14}C dating of the deposits has shown 24.438 ± 0.350 ka. Insects are mostly represented by Coleoptera (59 species of 13 families) and dominated by species of Curculionidae, especially *Otiorhynchus*, and Carabidae.
