Chapter two discusses the three most common choices for the author of Hebrews: Barnabas, Apollos, and Paul. First, Allen frequently argues for Lukan authorship specifically because Luke is a better candidate than Paul (e.g., pp. 96, 133, 171, 236). In these cases, "unique" means "not in Paul."
