The two principal functions of knowledge—research and the transmission of acquired learning—have been transformed by the leading sciences and technologies of telematics, cybernetics, informatics, and the expansion of computer languages. According to Lyotard (1984, p. 4), “Knowledge is and will be produced in order to be sold; it is and will be consumed in order to be valorized in a new production; in both cases, the goal is exchange”.
