I. The Old Testament is divided into three major sections: the Law, the Psalms, and the Prophets - Luke 24:44. A. The Law refers to the first five books: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy. B. The Prophets or teachings were divided by the Jews into two sets: 1. The Former Prophets: Joshua, Judges, I Samuel, II Samuel, I Kings, II Kings. 2. The Latter Prophets: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, and the twelve smaller books from Hosea to Malachi. C. The Psalms or holy writings: Psalms, Proverbs, Job, Song of Solomon, Ruth, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, Esther, Daniel, Ezra, Nehemiah, I The prophets peopled the pages of Israel's history.
