Does "beer" broadly refer to fermented beverages based on grain or does it designate the hopped drink obtained from liqueed starch after fermentation with specic strains of Saccha-romyces yeasts, which is understood to be beer in our times? globalization generates new variants of beer-like beverages that follow regional traditions and preferences.
